

## **CHURCHES IN PONTE DELLA MUDA**

### **NEW PARISH CHURCH**

The new parish church, palced in Monte Piana street, was inaugurated in 1968 by *Mons. Albino Luciani*. During the last years, some works has been realized thanks to the generosity of the faithful people. Inside there are some modern artistic creations, such as: wooden sculptures, mosaics, a basrelief and six frescos.

### **ANCIENT PARISH CHURCH**

The ancient parish church, known as "S. Valentine's church", dates XVIIth century. The wooden with dedication to St.Valentino was surely created by the carvers from Ceneda called Ghirlanduzzi, who were active from second to eighth decade of '600 (more info by Roberto Meneghetti available in the site).

Recently the church has been restored and brought back to its ancient beauty.

The little external area has been paved in order to be available to local shows.

The pre-festive Mess is celebrated on Saturday evening at 18 p.m. (winter time) or 19 p.m. (summer time).

### **LITTLE CHURCH VOTED TO SANT'ANTONIO**

This little church was built for the devotion of the inhabitants of Palù (a little country area) just after the end of the first world war and was voted to Virgin Mary and to S. Antony from Padova.

Recently the Cordignano Alpine Team has generously carried out a restore and beautification work on the church.

Every 13 June (S. Antony) and 21 November (Presentation of the Virgin Mary - Health Madonna) the local inhabitants join for a great celebration of the Eucharisty, together with the faithful from Ponte and from the nearby.

Every first Sunday of each month (since April to October) the parish celebrate the Mess at 7.30 a.m..
